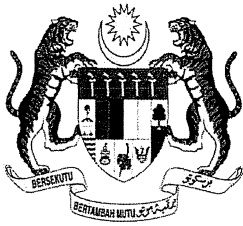

NOTICE OF INITIATION OF ANTI-DUMPING DUTY INVESTIGATION WITH REGARD TO  
IMPORTS OF FLAT-ROLLED PRODUCTS OF IRON ALLOY OR NON-ALLOY STEEL,  
PLATED OR COATED WITH ZINC, USING HOT DIP PROCESS (GALVANISED IRON  
COILS/SHEETS OR GALVANISED STEEL COILS/SHEETS) ORIGINATED OR EXPORTED  
FROM THE PEOPLE'S REPUBLIC OF CHINA, THE REPUBLIC OF KOREA AND  
THE SOCIALIST REPUBLIC OF VIET NAM

PURSUANT to section 20 of the Countervailing and Anti-Dumping Duties Act 1993 [Act 504] and regulation 7 of the Countervailing and Anti-Dumping Duties Regulations 1994 [P.U. (A) 233/1994], the Government has received a petition alleging that the imports of flat-rolled products of iron alloy or non-alloy steel, plated or coated with zinc, using hot dip process (galvanised iron coils/sheets or galvanised steel coils/sheets) originated or exported from the People's Republic of China, the Republic of Korea and the Socialist Republic of Viet Nam ("subject merchandise") are being dumped in Malaysia causing material injury to the domestic industry in Malaysia producing the like product ("Malaysian industry"), and the Government has decided that an anti-dumping duty investigation be initiated.

**Petition**

1. The petition was lodged by—

Malaysia,

the domestic producer of flat-rolled products of iron alloy or non-alloy steel, plated or coated with zinc, using hot dip process (galvanised iron coils/sheets or galvanised steel coils/sheets) on behalf of the Malaysian industry.

**Subject merchandise**

2. (1) The subject merchandise alleged to have been dumped in Malaysia is the flat-rolled products of iron alloy or non-alloy steel, plated or coated with zinc, using hot dip process (galvanised iron coils/sheets or galvanised steel coils/sheets) which is classified under the Harmonised System Code ("H.S. Code") and ASEAN Harmonised Tariff Nomenclature ("AHTN") 7210.49.11 00, 7210.49.14 00, 7210.49.15 00, 7210.49.16 00, 7210.49.17 00, 7210.49.18 00, 7210.49.19 00, 7210.49.91 00, 7210.49.99 00, 7212.30.11 00, 7212.30.12 00, 7212.30.13 00, 7212.30.14 00, 7212.30.19 00, 7212.30.90 00, 7225.92.20 00, 7225.92.90 00, 7225.99.90 00, 7226.99.11 00, 7226.99.19 00, 7226.99.91 00 and 7226.99.99 00.

(2) The H.S. Code and AHTN specified in subparagraph (1) are given only for information and have no binding effect on the classification of the subject merchandise.

**Allegation of dumping**

3. (1) The allegation of dumping is based on a comparison between the normal value of the subject merchandise in the People's Republic of China, the Republic of Korea and the Socialist Republic of Viet Nam with their corresponding export prices when the subject merchandise is exported to Malaysia.

(2) Based on this comparison, the dumping margins as alleged by the petitioner are significant for the producers or exporters.

**Allegation of injury**

4. (1) The petitioner has stated and provided evidence that the imports of the subject merchandise from the People's Republic of China, the Republic of Korea and the Socialist Republic of Viet Nam have increased in terms of absolute quantity.

(2) It was further alleged that the effect of such dumping, the Malaysian industry has suffered injury, namely increased in import volume, reduction in market share, decline in profitability, reduction in return on investment, reduction in return on total assets, price undercutting, price depression, price suppression and inability to raise capital.

**Procedure**

5. (1) Having determined that sufficient evidence exists to warrant an anti-dumping duty investigation to be initiated and such investigation is in the public interest, the Government initiates an investigation pursuant to section 20 of the Countervailing and Anti-Dumping Duties Act 1993 and subregulation 7(1) of the Countervailing and Anti-Dumping Duties Regulations 1994.

(2) The investigation will determine the existence, degree and effect of the alleged dumping of the subject merchandise to Malaysian industry.

**Questionnaire**

6. (1) For the purpose of obtaining information deemed necessary for the investigation, the Government will send questionnaires to—

- (a) the Malaysian industry and any association of producers in Malaysia;
- (b) the producers or exporters of the subject merchandise from the People's Republic of China, the Republic of Korea and the Socialist Republic of Viet Nam named in the petition;
- (c) the importers and any association of importers named in the petition; and
- (d) the Government of the People's Republic of China, the Republic of Korea and the Socialist Republic of Viet Nam.

(2) In any event, all interested parties not contacted by the Ministry of Investment, Trade and Industry (MITI) are invited to contact MITI in writing, by post, facsimile, e-mail or by hand in order to find out whether they are listed in this petition.

(3) If necessary, such interested parties may request for a copy of the questionnaires by identifying the nature of their business activities related to the investigation.

**Collection of information**

7. All interested parties are invited to make their views known in writing, in particular by responding to the questionnaires addressed to them and by providing supporting evidence.

**Time limit**

8. (1) Any interested party who desires to request for a questionnaire shall do so not later than fifteen days after the publication of this notice in the *Gazette*.

(2) All interested parties shall present their views in writing and submit questionnaire responses within the period of thirty days from the date of publication of this notice in the *Gazette* if such views and responses are to be taken into consideration during the anti-dumping duty investigation, unless otherwise specified.

**Submission of information, questionnaire response and correspondence**

9. (1) All submissions of information, questionnaire responses, correspondences and requests shall be made in writing and sent by post, facsimile, e-mail or by hand with clear indication of the name, address, e-mail address, telephone and facsimile numbers of the interested parties to—
