NOTICE OF INITIATION OF EXPIRY REVIEW OF ANTI-DUMPING DUTIES WITH REGARD
TO IMPORTS OF PREPAINTED, PAINTED OR COLOUR COATED STEEL COILS
ORIGINATING OR EXPORTED FROM THE PEOPLE'S REPUBLIC OF CHINA
AND THE SOCIALIST REPUBLIC OF VIET NAM

(AD 02/15 – SR 01/26)

FOLLOWING the publication of the Notice of Impending Termination of the Imposition of Anti-Dumping Duties on Imports of Prepainted, Painted or Colour Coated Steel Coils Originating or Exported from the People's Republic of China and the Socialist Republic of Viet Nam [*P.U. (B) 6/2026*] in the *Gazette* on 8 January 2026, the Government has received a request for an expiry review on the imposition of anti-dumping duties on the imports of prepainted, painted or colour coated steel coils originating or exported from the People's Republic of China and the Socialist Republic of Viet Nam ("subject merchandise") and pursuant to subsection 28c(6) of the Countervailing and Anti-Dumping Duties Act 1993 [*Act 504*], the Government initiates an expiry review on the imposition of anti-dumping duties on the subject merchandise.

Request for expiry review

1. The request for expiry review was lodged by the following domestic producer in Malaysia for prepainted, painted or colour coated steel coils:

CSC Steel Sdn. Bhd.
180, Kawasan Perindustrian Ayer Keroh
Ayer Keroh, 75450 Melaka
Malaysia.

Subject merchandise

2. (1) The subject merchandise is classified under the Harmonised System Code (H.S. Code) and ASEAN Harmonised Tariff Nomenclature (AHTN) 7210.70.12 00, 7210.70.13 00, 7210.70.19 00, 7210.70.21 00, 7210.70.29 00, 7210.70.91 00 and 7210.70.99 00.

(2) The H.S. Code and AHTN specified in subparagraph (1) are given only for information and have no binding effect on the classification of the subject merchandise.

Existing anti-dumping duties

3. The anti-dumping duties currently in force on the subject merchandise are definitive anti-dumping duties imposed under the Customs (Anti-Dumping Duties) (Administrative Review) Order 2026 [*P.U. (A) 23/2026*].

Grounds for the expiry review

4. (1) The request for expiry review is based on the grounds that the termination of the anti-dumping duties currently in force would be likely to lead to a continuation or recurrence of dumping and injury to the Malaysian industry.

(2) The applicant presented sufficient evidence of the dumping and injury to the Malaysian industry and the causal link between the imports of the subject merchandise with the alleged injury suffered by the domestic industry in Malaysia.

(3) The Government is satisfied that the request carries sufficient grounds to initiate an expiry review.

(4) In coming to the decision, the Government has also examined the prices of the subject merchandise in the domestic market in Malaysia in relation to the likelihood of a continuation or recurrence of dumping.

Procedure

5. Having determined that there is sufficient evidence to warrant an expiry review of the anti-dumping duties with regard to the imports of subject merchandise, the Government will initiate an expiry review pursuant to subsection 28C(6) of the Countervailing and Anti-Dumping Duties Act 1993.

Questionnaires

6. (1) In order to obtain information deemed necessary for the expiry review, the Government may send questionnaires to the relevant interested parties.

(2) In any event, all interested parties not contacted by the Ministry of Investment, Trade and Industry (MITI) are invited to contact MITI by e-mail in order to find out whether they are listed in this expiry review.

(3) If necessary, such interested parties may request for a copy of the questionnaires by identifying the nature of their business activities related to the expiry review.

Collection of information

7. All interested parties are invited to make their views known by electronic means, in particular by responding to the questionnaires addressed to them and by providing supporting evidence.

Time limit

8. (1) Any interested party who desires to request for a questionnaire shall do so not later than fifteen days after the publication of this notice in the *Gazette*.

(2) All interested parties must present their views by electronic means and submit questionnaires responses within thirty days from the date of publication of this notice in the *Gazette* if such views and responses are to be taken into consideration during the anti-dumping duties expiry review, unless otherwise specified.

Submission of electronic information, questionnaires responses and correspondence

9. (1) All submissions of information and questionnaires responses must be made by electronic means via Trade Remedies Investigation Management System (TRIMA), which can be accessed at <https://traderemedies.miti.gov.my> and any request for clarification and correspondence may be directed to—
